TOPIC (S)	Objective: How to use basic principles of attack and defence to plan strategies and tactics for football. They work on improving the quality of their skills using various techniques. Students think about how to use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition. Students will be able to develop more complex ways of passing and receiving the ball to create scoring opportunities. Students will explore different formations to play against different opposition tactics. Students will explore tactics in greater sided games.	Objective: Replicating and developing techniques as well as implementing and refining strategic play to outwit opponents. Students will be able to demonstrate the essential elements of attack and defence. Students will develop the use of smash shots and disguised shots to outwit opponents. Students should be able to accurately score and officiate singles and doubles badminton games. Pupils develop doubles attack and defence tactics.	Objective: Demonstrate skills individually and in combination. Explore partner work counter balance/counter tension, group work on floor and apparatus Developing stability when holding their own body position and when supporting a partner. Pupils incorporate control, precision and aesthetics into sequences showing creativity. Students will evaluate and assess movements to improve sequences.	Objective: Refining and developing core skills of netball; passing, catching, footwork, dodging, marking and shooting. How to use basic principles of attack and defence to plan strategies and tactics. Focus on centre pass tactics and backline sequence of passing. Development of full games and tactics. Additional rules introduced.	Objective: To assess pupils in activity.	
Knowledge & Skills development	Outwitting an opponent: Pupils will identify different areas of the playing area and be able to move using a variety of techniques. Pupils will understand how to outwit opponents using strategies and tactics during game play. Pupils will learn and perform more basic skills with accuracy and control. Continual development and adaptation of the necessary skills will contribute to producing an improved performance. Developing Skills/Performance Pupils will develop the skills necessary to outwit opponents. Pupils will replicate techniques with control and accuracy Making and Applying Decisions Pupils should be able to recognise the importance of responding to changing situations within the game in attack and defence. Pupils will be constantly faced with strategic and tactical decisions based on movement of the ball/shuttle and opponent. Opportunities to score/coach pupils will develop communication and decision making skills. Evaluating and Improving Appropriate questioning on teaching points of the skills and processes developed. Observation and peer assessment. Provide opportunities for pupils to assess own performance and implement strategies for improvement.
