Students will have a forty-five-minute brunch break from 11:30am, and can purchase food from the canteen, should they wish to. The buses will run as normal in the morning and in the afternoon, there will be a reduced service. Students will be able to travel home on the 723, 725 (extended to Moorfield/Tower Hill), 727, 737 and 741 buses. The routes for these buses will provide coverage to all areas which are difficult to reach on public transport. Buses will depart at 12:45pm and the cost will be one pound per journey for those without a bus pass or day ticket.

Examination results days this year are 18 August for A level and level 3 BTEC and 25 August for GCSE and level 2 BTEC. Staff will be on site between 9:30-11:30am to support and advise students collecting results.
