## Maghull High School Uniform Policy



Following the uniform policy is an important part of a student's education and lifelong learning. It provides a sense of belonging, equality and encourages pride in being a member of Maghull High School and in their appearance.

### Uniform

Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform at all times.

**ALL UNIFORM SHOULD BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME**

- Maghull High blue blazer with the school badge Year 7,8 9
- V neck pullover with the school badge is for Year 10 & 11
- Optional: Navy blue plain pullover without badge can be worn under blazer. No cardigans
- White shirt or blouse
- Mid grey trousers
- Mid grey skirt pleated or A-Line or pinafore dress of a modest length
- Red and blue striped school tie
- Navy socks or black tights with skirt, black with trousers
- Black shoes (must be polishable, no trainers, sensible heels, See School Expectations booklet)
- Outdoor coat
- Plain headband, bobble or hair clip—black, blue.

### Games and Physical Education kit (BOYS)

Football boots  
Shin pads  
Clean indoor trainers (not school shoes)

### Games and Physical Education Kit (GIRLS)

Navy polo shirt with school badge  
Navy skort or shorts (with school badge)  
Outdoor 3/4 zip sweatshirt with school badge or navy hoodie with school badge  
Navy leggings with school name  
Navy football/ hockey socks and white short trainer socks  
Trainers  
Optional: Navy tracksuit bottoms, football boots

It is essential that long hair is tied up for PE and students must provide appropriate hair ties.

**Other equipment**
